Early Detection Matters

According to the CDC, women diagnosed with breast cancer at its earliest stage have a 99% chance of living for at least five years, compared to 32% for those diagnosed at the most advanced stage.

Genetic Cancer Risk

BRCA1 mutations are seen in about 7% of families with multiple breast cancers and in about 40% of families with ovarian and breast cancer. BRCA2 mutations are found in 20% of families at high risk for ovarian and breast cancers.
